

International Activities Fund for Undergraduates in Arts and Sciences at Washington University in St. Louis

This scholarship is available to undergraduates in Arts and Sciences who demonstrate a strong commitment to international activities in a variety of fields. Especially encouraged is international field research leading to a senior honors thesis, but other activities such as international or internationally-focused internships, assisting with faculty research overseas, or special language study will also be considered. Proposals for activities following the junior year are favored, as are proposals from International and Area Studies majors, but we will consider applications for all Arts and Sciences undergraduates (including graduating seniors). Proposals should contain a clearly stated research question or project statement, a realistic plan for use of the funds, and evidence of faculty interest and support. These grants are limited to \$1000 and applicants are strongly urged to apply to other sources as well in order to meet full costs.

Instructions for Applicants

The applicant must submit:

1) Application Form

Complete the application form attached. Be certain to confirm your eligibility for this grant and be sure to sign this form.

2) Current Resume

Indicate significant activities, achievements and work experience which demonstrate your interests and potential achievements. Do not exceed one page.

3) Current Transcript

You may submit an internal record of an up-to-date transcript.

4) Research Proposal or Statement of Project

In a statement of not more than one page, outline the research or activity you hope to undertake and the feasibility and necessity of undertaking it in the proposed country or countries. Be sure to give a detailed description of the proposed activity and also indicate sources of additional funding.

5) One Letter of Recommendation (second letter is optional)

Complete applications must be delivered to the International and Area Studies office, first floor of Stix International House, or Campus Box 1088, Washington University, One Brookings Drive, St. Louis, MO 63130 by the deadline.

Deadlines: Spring - second Friday in March, and Fall - second Friday in November
