



Fall Study Abroad: The Road Less Traveled

Top 10 Reasons to Consider Fall Study Abroad

- 1. Senior Thesis:** You will have more time to work with your major advisor(s) to develop senior projects and theses.
- 2. Internships:** Dates for internships and jobs for summer after junior year are often incompatible with spring study abroad program dates.
- 3. Smaller Program Size:** You get more individualized attention. There will likely be fewer study abroad students and tourists in your host country. Program capacity limits are less likely to be a problem. Housing options may be better.
- 4. Leadership:** Since you will be here for 3 semesters after studying abroad, more leadership opportunities in campus organizations may be available upon return and you will have a longer continuous block of time to devote to them.
- 5. Fellowships:** You will have more time to prepare scholarship and fellowship applications that are due in September (e.g. Rhodes and Fulbright).
- 6. Housing:** You will have an easier time finding on campus and off campus housing in the spring semester.
- 7. Program Extension:** On some programs, you may have the option of extending your study abroad into the spring semester if you wish.
- 8. Tests:** Dates for spring/summer standardized tests for professional school (e.g. LSAT) conflict with dates of most spring study abroad programs.
- 9. Enjoy Spring Twice:** If you participate in a study abroad program in the Southern hemisphere, you can take classes during the host country's spring semester, enjoy the warm summer weather traveling at the end of the program, and return for WU's spring semester.
- 10. Life After Graduation:** You will have more time to prepare for life after graduation, whether that entails a job search, graduate program applications, or a transitional experience.
